

Southern NSW Yard Dog Circuit Challenge 2022



Five Southern NSW Yard Dog Clubs have introduced a trial circuit Challenge for 2022, to be held in conjunction with scheduled trial events. The Challenge will be run within the Open category at each trial. Winners will be decided and announced at the West Wyalong trial in August 2022.

Competition Rules:

- Competitors can enter no more than two dogs into the challenge.
- Dogs must be either Improver or Open dogs prior to the Gundagai Trial, and entered* and compete in the Open events at a minimum of four trials.
- Where trials conduct separate Improver and Open events, the dog must compete in the Open event.
- Scores awarded in Open Rounds (not Finals) will be used to calculate final challenge scores.
- Where a dog does not compete at a trial a score of Zero will be awarded.
- The top four scores will be used to calculate final results, and the highest total score wins.

Entry Fees:

- Entry Fee: \$25.00 per dog, to be paid in cash at or before the Gundagai trial with entry form to Neale Taylor or Peter Darmody.
- Late entries accepted until/at the Dalgety trial, with a zero-score awarded for the Gundagai trial.
**Entry into the Challenge does not cover entry for the trial events, and dogs competing in the challenge must be entered in Open events as required by individual trials.*
