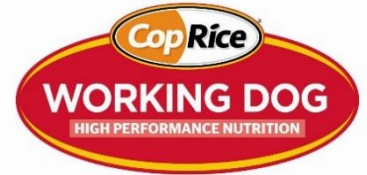

The all-round dog award for both the Novice & Open classes will be given to the nominated dog with the highest aggregate first round score from each event (paddock and yard).

Saturday 22nd April 2023

Yard Trial will be run on Saturday with Novice, Maiden and Open classes.

Individual prizes will be given for each class. Dogs may enter up into the Open, only if they are also entered in the Open paddock section.

Sunday 23rd April 2023

Novice and Open paddock section will be run on Sunday. The Open will involve a long cast with a lift and draw and the Novice course will be similar, although with a smaller cast.

Paddock section will involve more than three sheep and will **NOT** mirror a three sheep course.

Individual prizes will be given for each class.
