
## **Acceptance of Risk**

## **Rules and Conditions**

Competitors of the Ultimate Stock Dog should pride themselves on good stockmanship and take care and responsibility for all animals under their control.

The following rules and conditions must be read by competitors before submitting their entries.

The all round stock dog winner will be awarded to the dog with the highest combined score of all three events.

To be eligible for the **Rookie** category <u>you</u>, the handler, must not have won a novice or higher classed event in any yard, 3 sheep or cattle trial.

If you have entered the **Rookie** category you are ineligible for the all round **USD** title.

The **Rookie** winner will be awarded to the dog with the highest combined score of all three events amongst the other rookie handler entries.

In each individual event there will be a first place offered to the dog with the highest score (no further placing's in individual events).

In the event of a tie, first place will be awarded to the dog with the quickest time of all three events combined, this will be implemented in any tie across the whole event.

A maximum of 50 (includes Rookies) entries will be taken (the committee may change this number prior to the event to fit with the schedule).

A maximum of 2 dogs per handler or 1 dog per Rookie handler.

No bitches in oestrus permitted on the grounds.

Handlers may substitute their dog prior to the event with approval of the committee.

Dogs cannot be substituted once the event has commenced, the same dog must complete all three events.

The three events are:

Yard- This section may include obstacles such as a drenching race, draft and loading truck etc.

Paddock- This section may include obstacles such as a gap, race, put away pen etc.

Cattle- This section may include obstacles such as a drive, gate, gap etc.

Each event will be judged by judges of their respective fields. The judge and committee have the right to adjust rules to fit in with the competition. The judge's decision is final.

The courses may be adapted from traditional events to fit in with the competition.

All competitors enter at their own risk, no responsibility will be accepted for damage or injury to dogs or property by the organising committee.

This is a stand alone event and  $\underline{\text{will not}}$  contribute towards any association point score.

No entries will be refunded

Entries will close once full or by 17th May, 2024.



On arrival please stay off both the racecourse and trotting tracks.

Camping available on site with power and water at \$30 per night.

Amenities include toilets and shower block.

Catering available throughout the course of the event.
